OES

There are seven states without the Obsceny Exemption Statute (OES): **Alaska, Arizona, Colorado, Missouri, Oklahoma, New Jersey and Rhode Island.**

Forty-three states have an OES shielding administrators and teachers from arrest and prosecution when showing illegal obscenity to your children or grandchildren.

OESs were passed in the 1970s. They are based on two books written by pedophile Alfred Kinsey. (In fact, his books contain TABLE 34, which show the number of orgasms stimulated by pedophiles on children as young as 2 months old during a 24-hour time period.)



School Employees Can Give Obscenity to Our Children!



They hide behind a loophole called the **Obscenity Exemption Statute (OES)**

Sexual Predators Are Lurking in Schools

Nearly every state has loopholes in their obscenity laws that protect school employees from prosecution, if they give obscene materials to children. By exempting “educational” materials from obscenity laws, students are often exposed to erotic information and groomed to accept sexual exploitation as a social norm. Any adult other than a teacher would be arrested and jailed for breaking obscenity laws.

These loopholes have already had devastating results. One study estimated that one in 10 students will experience sexual abuse or misconduct at the hands of a school authorities during their K-12 education.



This means an estimated 4.5 million students will be victimized by school authorities before today’s kindergarteners graduate from high school. This study found sexual misconduct across geographically and demographically diverse school districts and in all five districts surveyed in 2014.

We must protect our children and hold teachers and school employees to the same legal standards as required of every other adult in America. Every child deserves a safe environment to learn and grow. Under the obscenity loopholes, however, every student is a potential victim.

Examples of Obscenity in Schools

The fact that *It’s Perfectly Normal* uses cartoons to communicate obscenity is particularly harmful for children. Other comprehensive sexuality education materials often give students links to websites which are sexually explicit with adult hard-core porn just a few mouse clicks away. Many schools do not have adequate filters for computers with internet access.


